TAXATION REVENUE STATISTICS – April 2019

Taxable Sales by County

The Nevada Department of Taxation released statewide taxable sales for April 2019, which total \$5,176,462,594. That represents a 4.6 percent increase over April 2018. Eight of Nevada's 17 counties recorded increases.

Taxable Sales by Industry Sector

Nine out of the state's ten largest industry sectors saw year-over-year growth in April 2019. On-line/non-store retailers continue to experience large year-over-year growth due in part to new regulations expanding sales tax to more on-line retailers.

Monthly excise tax collections totaled \$56,408,678 in April. Through the first ten months of the fiscal year, total excise tax collections are 7.9 percent higher than during the same period in Fiscal Year 2018.
