Taxable Sales by County

The Nevada Department of Taxation released statewide taxable sales for May 2019, which total \$5,435,985,733. That represents a 7.7 percent increase over May 2018. Eleven of Nevada's 17 counties recorded increases.

Monthly excise tax collections totaled \$55,251,363 in May. Through the first eleven months of the fiscal year, total excise tax collections are 7.8 percent higher than during the same period in Fiscal Year 2018.
