TAXATION REVENUE STATISTICS – August 2019

Taxable Sales by County

The Nevada Department of Taxation released statewide taxable sales for August 2019, which total \$5,410,952,341. That represents a 7.6 percent increase over August 2018. Eleven of Nevada's 17 counties recorded increases.
