Monthly Excise Tax Revenue Collections – October 2019

Monthly excise tax collections totaled \$56,529,196 in October, while the Commerce Tax (due annually) took in \$1,015,675 during the month. Nine of these eleven tax types saw increased revenue this fiscal year versus the prior fiscal year.
