#### **TAXATION REVENUE STATISTICS - April 2020**

### **Taxable Sales by County**

The Nevada Department of Taxation released statewide taxable sales for April 2020, which total \$3,670,368,962. That represents a decline of 29.1 percent over April 2019, largely due to nonessential business closures in response to the Covid-19 pandemic. Eight of Nevada's rural counties recorded increases.
