TAXATION REVENUE STATISTICS - April 2021

Taxable Sales by County

The Nevada Department of Taxation released statewide taxable sales for April 2021, which total \$6,341,481,016. That represents an increase of 72.8 percent from April 2020. Fifteen of Nevada's seventeen counties recorded increases compared to the prior April.
