## **TAXATION REVENUE STATISTICS – January 2021**

### **Taxable Sales by County**

The Nevada Department of Taxation released statewide taxable sales for January 2021, which total \$4,899,415,525. That represents a decline of 4.1 percent from January 2020. Nine of Nevada's seventeen counties recorded increases.

#### Monthly Excise Tax Revenue Collections – January 2021

Monthly excise tax collections totaled \$35,692,101 in January. This total does not include the Lodging Tax distributed by the Department since those disbursements occur on a different schedule than the remaining excise taxes.
