The Nevada Department of Taxation released statewide taxable sales for July 2021, which total \$6,513,146,350. Twelve of the State's 17 counties recorded increases from the prior July.

Monthly Excise Tax Revenue Collections – July 2021

Monthly excise tax collections totaled \$41,364,644 in July. The table below shows the monthly collections for July 2021, as well as the total fiscal year percentage change (equal to the year-over-year change, as July 2021 is the first period in Fiscal Year 2022). This table does not include the Lodging Tax distributed by the Department since those disbursements occur on a different schedule than the remaining excise taxes.
