# **TAXATION REVENUE STATISTICS – October 2020**

## **Taxable Sales by County**

The Nevada Department of Taxation released statewide taxable sales for October 2020, which total \$580,996,195. That represents a decline of 2.8 percent from October 2019. Twelve of Nevada's seventeen counties recorded increases.
