Taxable Sales by County

The Nevada Department of Taxation released statewide taxable sales for January 2020, which total \$5,111,298,006. That represents a 5.6 percent increase over January 2019. Thirteen of Nevada's 17 counties recorded increases.

Monthly Excise Tax Revenue Collections – January 2020

Monthly excise tax collections totaled \$56,095,311 in January, while the Commerce Tax (due annually) took in \$1,004,650 during the month. Nine of these tax types have seen increased revenue this fiscal year versus the prior fiscal year.
