Summary

The matter of the Taxpayer's petition for review of property valuations for the 2013-14 Secured Roll within Clark County, Nevada, originally came before the State Board of Equalization (State Board) for hearing in Las Vegas, Nevada, on September 16, 2013 after due notice to the Taxpayer and the Assessor. The matter was continued for hearing in Las Vegas to October 2, 2013.

The State Board, having considered all evidence, documents and testimony pertaining to the valuation of the property in accordance with NRS 361.227, hereby makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Decision.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1) The State Board is an administrative body created pursuant to NRS 361.375.
- 2) The State Board is mandated to hear all appeals of property tax assessments pursuant to NRS 361.360 and NRS 361.400.
- 3) The Taxpayer and the Assessor were given adequate, proper and legal notice of the time and place of the hearing before the State Board, and the matter was properly noticed pursuant to the Open Meeting Law at NRS 241.020. *See Record, SBE page 105.*
- 4) The subject property consists of a 62,268 square foot storage warehouse built in 1995 and located on 3.37 acres on East Craig Road in North Las Vegas, Clark County, Nevada. *See Record, SBE pages 9, 27, and 94-96; Tr., 10-2-13, p. 113, ll. 12-15.*
- 5) The Clark County Board of Equalization (County Board) ordered the total taxable value for the subject property of \$2,311,882 be upheld for the 2013-2014 secured roll. *See Record, SBE pages 15 and 100.*
- 6) The Taxpayer presented sufficient evidence to support a value different from that established by the County Board. The State Board tested the taxable value with an income approach, using a net operating income of \$179,612 and a capitalization rate of 8.5%, resulting in an estimate of value of \$2,113,082 or about \$34 per square foot. The State Board found that \$35 per square foot was well-supported by both sales and an income indicator of value. *See Tr., 10-2-13, p. 121, l. 18 through p. 122, l. 122.*
- 7) The State Board found the taxable value of the subject property should be reduced to \$2,179,380 or \$35 per square foot. *See Tr., 10-2-13, p. 123, ll. 2-12.*
- 8) The assessed value as adjusted by the State Board is 35% of taxable value.
- 9) Any finding of fact above construed to constitute a conclusion of law is adopted as such to the same extent as if originally so denominated.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1) The Taxpayer timely filed a notice of appeal, and the State Board accepted jurisdiction to determine this matter.
- 2) The Taxpayer and the Assessor are subject to the jurisdiction of the State Board.
- 3) The State Board has the authority to determine the taxable values in the State.
- 4) The subject property is appraised, as adjusted, at the proper taxable value in accordance with NRS 361.227.
- 5) Any conclusion of law above construed to constitute a finding of fact is adopted as such to the same extent as if originally so denominated.

DECISION

The Petition of the Taxpayer is granted based on the above Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law. The Clark County Comptroller is instructed to correct the assessment roll by adjusting the assessed valuation of the subject property as follows:
