## NOTICE OF DECISION

#### **Appearances**

No one appeared on behalf of Creative Choice West II, LP (Taxpayer).

#### Summary

The matter of the Taxpayer's petition for review of property valuations for the 2015-16 Secured Roll within Clark County, Nevada, came before the State Board of Equalization (State Board) for hearing in Henderson, Nevada, on May 5, 2015 after due notice to the Taxpayer and the Assessor.

Pursuant to NAC 361.7014, the Secretary to the State Board examined the petition of the Taxpayer and found the petition was timely filed to the State Board. See Record, SBE page 1. The Clark County Board of Equalization (County Board) denied jurisdiction with regard to APN 139-16-401-002.

At the hearing on May 5, 2015, the parties proposed to settle the matter before the State Board by asking the State Board to overturn the decision of the County Board to not accept jurisdiction and to remand the case to the County Board for further proceedings on the original petition requesting a review of the valuation of the property. See Tr., 5-5-15, p. 302, II. 4-25. The State Board moved to approve the stipulated agreement proposed by the parties. See Tr., 5-5-15, p. 303, II. 1-18.

### DECISION

The State Board, having considered all evidence, documents and testimony, hereby overturns the decision of the County Board and remands this matter to the County Board with instructions to accept jurisdiction and to hear and decide the valuation issues related to the case.
