## Summary

The matter of the Department's direct appeal of the value of centrally assessed property on the 2021-2022 unsecured property tax roll and 2022-2023 secured property tax roll came before the State Board of Equalization (State Board) for hearing in Carson City and via Zoom meeting on March 28, 2022.

The Department presented the State Board with a signed Stipulation from the Taxpayer for review and approval by the State Board. The stipulation was signed by the Taxpayer on February 1, 2022, and by the Department on February 8, 2022.

## DECISION

The State Board, having considered the signed stipulation, voted unanimously to approve the stipulation presented. The taxable value for the properties subject to the direct appeal for the 2021-

2022 unsecured property tax roll and the 2022-2023 secured property tax roll shall be revised as set forth in the stipulation.
