My question is this: If a gallon of fuel is sold in Nevada for \$3.00, there are always Federal and State taxes embedded in that price. Let's say that they total 70¢. Is the entire \$3.00 subject to the gross receipts tax, or is it \$2.30, which is the amount net of taxes?
