


# OIL, GAS AND GEOTHERMAL WELL INSPECTIONS

  - 122 of 123 permitted oil-related wells
  - 410 of 426 geothermal wells
- Results:
  - 15 signage-related issues
  - 10 housekeeping
  - No fines






# Nevada Geothermal Energy
