Summary

The matter of the Taxpayer's petition for review of property valuations for the 2015-17 Secured Roll within Clark County, Nevada, came before the State Board of Equalization (State Board) for hearing in Las Vegas, Nevada, on July 18, 2016 after due notice to the Taxpayer and the Assessor.

The subject property consists of office furniture and fixtures.

At the hearing on July 18, 2016, the parties proposed to settle the matter and offered to stipulate to a final taxable value for review and approval by the State Board. See *Tr.*, 7-18-16, p.74, ll. 1-9. The State Board moved to approve the stipulated agreement proposed by the parties. See *Tr.*, 7-18-16, p.76, l. 17 through p. 77, l. 4.

DECISION

The State Board, having considered all evidence, documents and testimony, hereby approves the taxable values proposed by the parties for the subject property, case number 16-269.

The Assessor is instructed to correct the assessment roll by adjusting the assessed valuation of the subject property as follows:
