**Taxable Sales by County**

The Nevada Department of Taxation released statewide taxable sales for April 2022, which total \$7,045,431,634. Ten of the State's 17 counties recorded increases from the prior April.

All ten of the state's largest industries (by taxable sales volume) saw over-the-year gains in April. Of these sectors, Food Services/Drinking Places and Clothing and Clothing Accessories Stores saw the largest relative gains from April 2021.
