TAXATION REVENUE STATISTICS – August 2022

Taxable Sales by County

The Nevada Department of Taxation released statewide taxable sales for August 2022, which total \$7,016,983,284. Thirteen of the State’s 17 counties recorded increases from the prior August.

Nine of the state’s largest industries (by taxable sales volume) saw over-the-year gains in August. Of these sectors, Food Services/Drinking Places and Motor Vehicle/Parts Dealers saw the largest relative gains from August 2021.
