**TAXATION REVENUE STATISTICS – July 2022**

**Taxable Sales by County**

The Nevada Department of Taxation released statewide taxable sales for July 2022, which total \$6,938,504,946. Ten of the State's 17 counties recorded increases from the prior July.

**Taxable Sales by Industry Sector**

Seven of the state's largest industries (by taxable sales volume) saw over-the-year gains in July. Of these sectors, Nonstore Retailers and Merchant Wholesalers, Durable Goods saw the largest relative gains from July 2021.
