**TAXATION REVENUE STATISTICS – September 2022**

**Taxable Sales by County**

The Nevada Department of Taxation released statewide taxable sales for September 2022, which total \$7,469,340,291. Sixteen of the State's 17 counties recorded increases from the prior September.

**Taxable Sales by Industry Sector**

Eight of the state's largest industries (by taxable sales volume) saw over-the-year gains in September. Of these sectors, Merchant Wholesalers, Durable Goods and Food Services/Drinking Places saw the largest relative gains from September 2021.
