

Nevada Proposed Recreational Marijuana Regulations

Sec. 20. Marijuana distributor duties and responsibilities.

1. A licensed marijuana distributor may transport marijuana and marijuana products between a marijuana establishment and:

- (a) Another marijuana establishment;
- (b) Between the buildings of the marijuana establishment; and
- (c) To the State Department of Agriculture for laboratory testing.

2. Before transporting marijuana or marijuana products pursuant to subsection 1 of this chapter, a licensed marijuana distributor must:

- (a) Complete a trip plan that includes, without limitation:
 - (1) The name of the marijuana establishment agent in charge of the transportation;
 - (2) The date and start time of the trip;
 - (3) A description, including the amount, of the marijuana or marijuana products being transported; and
 - (4) The anticipated route of transportation.

MJ Freeway Comment:

We would recommend the Department of Taxation possibly consider including or clarifying if operators would be allowed or required to generate a trip plan from the Seed to Sale tracking system if the approved system enables the capability.

Additional data elements that should be considered for inclusion on a trip plan could include:

- Along with the business names, we would recommend considering including phone numbers, along with the license number of the shipping and receiving licensee;
- Unique identifying code(s);
 - A QR code that can be scanned by law enforcement and the Department to verify the authenticity of the trip plan; and
- In order to maintain transaction confidentiality, a shipping licensee may prepare a separate trip plan for each receiving licensee when shipping to multiple distinct licensed premises in a single day;
- Possibly requiring that the shipping manifest must be accessible from the transport vehicle at all times when cannabis is present; and

- Any individual transporting cannabis on behalf of a licensed cannabis business shall provide the shipping manifest and any transaction receipts for cannabis in transit upon request by the Department or its authorized agents, law enforcement, or other Federal, State, or local government officials if necessary to perform the official's functions and duties.
