Medical Marijuana Patient Lobbyists & Advocacy for Nevada

It's crucial you understand that medical mj patients have serious concerns Nevada still must see properly addressed if patients are to participate in the cannabis consumer market with confidence.

- * Lab methodologies must be standardized.
- * Live plants, freshly harvested plant matter, and cannabis seeds should all be available for purchase by Nevada's medical mj program registrants.
- * Cannabis concentrates should be tested for specific safety levels and categorized by levels of purity as this is absolutely essential for consumer safety!
- * Proper patient serving-size should be allotted as it was miscalculated.
- * Create medical marijuana establishment "standards of procedure" to include medical card holders trained on the Metrc system to act as managers, and implement policy that requires lab managers to be on site for their full 8 hour shift.
- * Establish a state certified "organic panel" of chemicals for use on cannabis agriculture and procedures that protect against chemical subterfuge.
- * Require the Independent Laboratory Advisory Committee to consider public input and construct a compliancy plan that includes regular round robin testing on a continuing and regular basis.
- * Allocate funding for the proper toxicology testing related to pesticides, growth enhancers, and the various additives used for cannabis agriculture and processing.
- * Require the Dept of Agriculture and the Health Dept to maintain a seat on the Independent Laboratory Advisory Committee.
- * Adopt consumption laws that serve medical mj patient needs and keeps them protected.
- * Patients want measures of transparency implemented related to failed cannabis products and have this information posted on the state website along with proper patient advocacy.
