Public comments should include the full name of the commenter. Text of any public comment may be read into the record. Public comment may be limited to three minutes as a reasonable time, place, and manner restriction, but may not be limited based upon viewpoint. Content may be redacted due to inappropriate language. Written public comments must be submitted prior to 5:00 p.m., Wednesday, June 17, 2020 via e-mail at regulations@ccb.nv.gov. Comments received after the cut-off and before the start of the second public comment agenda item may be read into the record during the second public comment agenda item at the Chair's discretion. All written public comments shall, in their entirety, be included as part of the public record.
