



TRAINING IS KEY!!!



NRS 370.521(1) prohibits the sale of tobacco products to any person under the age of 21

In accordance with **NRS 370.521(6)**, a person who violates subsection 1 is liable for the following civil penalties*:


- ❖ 1st Violation - \$100
- ❖ 2nd Violation - \$250
- ❖ 3rd+ Violation - \$500


****EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2024****


In accordance with **NRS 370.521(7)**, if an employee or agent of a licensee has violated subsection 1, the licensee is liable for the following civil penalties*:

- ❖ 1st Violation - \$2,500
- ❖ 2nd Violation - \$5,000
- ❖ 3rd Violation - \$7,500
- ❖ 4th+ Violation - \$10,000



 **Ask!** Train all employees to ask for ID for tobacco purchases!

 **Scan!** Train all employees to scan or use automated software** for age verification!

 **Verify!** Train all employees on how to find the Date of Birth on an ID to verify again!

*Civil penalty assessments under NRS 370.521 are based on the initial violation and subsequent violations occurring within a 24-month period at the same premises.

** Under NRS 370.521(3), a person must perform age-verification using a scanning technology or other automated, software-based system for tobacco sales to any person under 40 years of age. A person who violates this subsection is liable for a civil penalty of \$100 for each offense.
