Nevada Department of Taxation Announces Launch Date for Phase 2 of My Nevada Tax

Carson City, NV – The Nevada Department of Taxation will launch Phase 2 of My Nevada Tax on December 8, 2025, further expanding the platform's capabilities to enhance taxpayer access, efficiency and self-service tools.

Phase 2 introduces support for the Modified Business Tax (MBT) and Commerce Tax, enabling businesses across Nevada to file, manage and pay these taxes through the secure, streamlined My Nevada Tax portal.

With the launch of this new phase, users now have access to a broader set of features, including:

- **Update Account Information**
- **View and Manage Permits and Licenses**
- **Business Registration & Access**
- **Manage Multiple Locations**
- **Schedule Appointments**
- **Manage Corporate Officers**
- **File Returns**
- **Close an Account**

Businesses previously filing on paper or using the Nevada Tax Center are encouraged to transition to My Nevada Tax for improved access and convenience. The Department offers step-by-step guides, tutorials and customer support to assist users throughout the transition.
