

Nevada County Population Projections 2025 to 2044

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Introduction to the 2025 Population Projections

The following is the 2025 edition of the 20-year population projections for Nevada based on the state and county population estimates for July 1, 2024, as certified by the Governor on March 1, 2025. The 20-year population projections are published each October by the Nevada State Demographer in accordance with NRS 360.289 pertaining to the annual reports of projected population of counties. The Regional Economic Models, Inc. (REMI) model v3.3.0 was used to project how the population might change given demographic and economic factors.

The REMI model provides information for all 17 Nevada counties by 23 major economic sectors. It looks at the interaction between the economic and demographic characteristics within a county, as well as the dynamic economic and demographic relationships between the 17 counties and the United States as a whole. The 20-year projections will change each year as data becomes available or is revised.

The REMI model provides a standard national and regional control forecast that serves as an “out-of-the-box” baseline (the model as delivered, without user modifications). To refine this baseline, sector employment data from the Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS) Quarterly Census of Employment and Wages (QCEW) was analyzed, comparing 2nd Quarter 2023 to 2nd Quarter 2024 for both the nation and each Nevada county. The resulting change rates were applied to the model to adjust the 2024 sector employment forecasts. Additional adjustments were incorporated using employment projections for current and upcoming economic development projects provided by the Governor’s Office of Economic Development (GOED). These combined change rates were then applied to the baseline population from the 2024 Governor’s certified estimates to project state and county totals through 2044. Finally, to ensure demographic consistency, migration adjustments were anchored to the Census Bureau’s Annual and Cumulative Estimates of the Components of Resident Population Change for Nevada counties.

These projections will be used as the control populations for the age, sex, race and Hispanic origin projections. A summary table is provided on the next page, followed by full projections by county at the end of this document.

Risks to these projections for consideration:

- Limited housing stock in some counties may constrain population growth relative to the projections.
- The REMI model may not entirely predict employee commuting patterns, especially in rural areas, which could impact the population distribution among adjacent counties.
- Population movement could vary if migration slows, out-migration increases, commuting patterns shift, or future policy changes influence migration flows.
- Fluctuations in business investment, consumer demand, or overall economic stability could affect household formation and migration trends.
