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This is a reminder that the Nevada Commerce Tax Return for the 2025–2026 tax year is due on August 14, 2026.

The Nevada Commerce Tax applies to businesses operating within Nevada whose gross revenue exceeds \$4,000,000 during the fiscal year. The tax applies to revenue generated in Nevada, and the applicable tax rate varies by industry, including sectors such as retail, manufacturing and services.

Please keep the following information in mind:

- Commerce Tax Credit for Modified Business Tax: Eligible businesses may claim a credit against the Modified Business Tax if they meet the applicable requirements.
- Exempt Status: Businesses with gross revenue of \$4,000,000 or less during the fiscal year are exempt from the Commerce Tax filing requirement.

Important Filing Information

- The Commerce Tax return is due 45 days after the close of the fiscal year ending June 30.
- For the 2025–2026 tax year, the filing deadline is August 14, 2026.
- If the due date falls on a weekend or state holiday, the deadline is automatically extended to the next business day.

Filing Options

You may file your Commerce Tax return in the following way:

To avoid penalties and interest, please ensure your return and any payment due are submitted by the filing deadline.
